Be a Part of the Noble Cause- Feeding Children

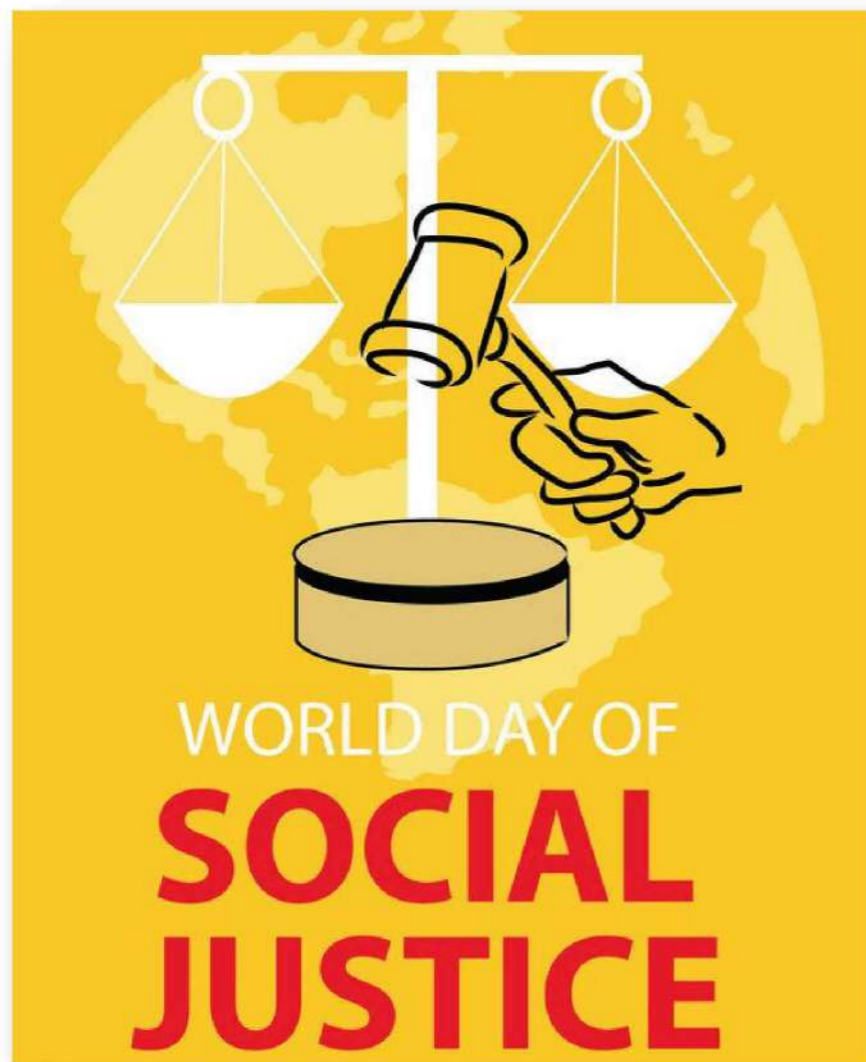

Thank you for Helping Bhagyashree Fight Against her Heart Defect



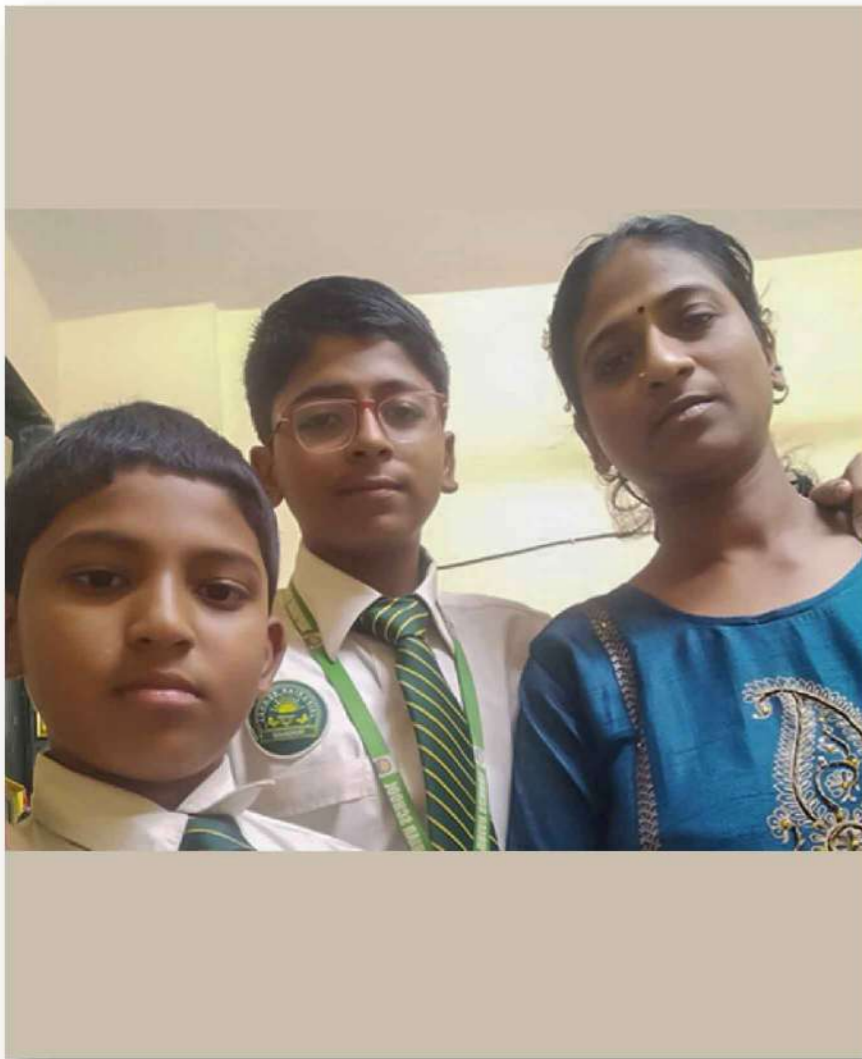
